B185 RESCUE AMBULANCE

A four wheeled mini multi-cab vehicle which is being solicited by Barangay 185 to the Rotary Club of San Diego Southbay, USA to serve the indigent constituents of the barangay. The vehicle will be utilized as a rescue ambulance that can easily navigate the narrow streets of the barangay during emergencies. The use of the new ambulance will be very convenient as the barangay needs to replace the old service patrol in transporting patients which is very stressful and uncomfortable on the part of the passengers who are already in need of medical attention.



What we wish to have...



B185 RESCUE AMBULANCE

Is a rapid response vehicle designed to transport sick or injured patients resulting from emergency and disasters. The vehicle have certain features of an Ambulance Service but is not equipped to respond to extreme serious medical emergencies. The operation of the Emergency and Rescue Team will be overseen by the Pasay City Disaster Risk Reduction Management Office who will also provide Skills Training needed to upgrade the knowledge, attitude and skills of volunteer responders.

A Sangguniang Barangay Resolution stating the ownership of the Rescue Vehicle by Barangay 185 acquired thru the generosity of the Rotary Club of San Diego Southbay will be in place. This will be covered by a Deed of Donation and Acknowledgement Receipt or Official Receipt.

The Rescue vehicle will be registered with the LTO under the name of Barangay 185, Zone 19, Pasay City. It shall be owned, managed and operated wholly by Barangay 185, Zone 19, Pasay City.

What we wish to have...



B185 RESCUE AMBULANCE

Barangay 185 shall utilize the vacant lot at the corner of Almazor St. and Andrew Avenue as Parking Space, Office space for operation and Dispatch.

There shall be a minimum of 2 qualified and competent responders (Standard First Aid Trained) and a driver per shift consisting of 2 shifts per day.

Procurement of the required additional medicines, equipments and supplies are already included in the Barangay Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Fund Investman Plan of the Barangay.

What we wish to have...



B185 RESCUE AMBULANCE

The following shall also be strictly imposed:

- ❖ An easy to reach stable cabinet will be installed in the vehicle to store the required equipment, medicines and supplies
- ❖ The use of PPE shall be strictly observed
- ❖ Presence of program for calibration, repair and maintenance of equipments including decontamination and disinfection
- ❖ A contingency plan on equipment breakdown especially during transport of patient

The rescue ambulance will have a communication radio linked to the base operation at Barangay 185 and Pasay DRRMO.

All patients being transported shall accomplish a standard record form including Waivers by the patient or his/her companion.

B185 RESCUE AMBULANCE

Barangay 185 shall maintain a system of recording and reporting of the patients condition. A logbook of accomplishments for inspection and monitoring of the Pasay City DRRMO.
