McCook Rotary Club presented McCook Elementary Schools with a \$1,000 check to be used for their Backpack Program (\$731 of district funds and \$269 local funds). The original grant was written for a total \$924 to sustain 4 children with 33 weeks of food. We added another 10 weeks of food for another child or children. In October 2018 club members met with the backpack director and assembled enough food into packs to last from October through March, until the next assembly party would be held.

The club learned how working together can achieve their goals. In October 2018, 8 club/3 family members met the McCook Backpack Director to assemble food into individual packs for elementary students in need of food over the weekends. From the director, the club learned more about the school system and how it strives to assist all their students in need, even though funds are not always readily available. The club learned that even though the program is in place, not all students are provided assistance. The director now knows the club is a phone call away when the need arises.
