	Total Budget	\$2,300

Total cost estimate for NVRT Accessibility and Navigation Project is \$10,000 USD. This amount includes design, construction and installation of 2 weatherproof trailhead kiosks (north and south end) with waterproof maps and way-finding signs. Updated brochures will be designed, printed and distributed and web updates will be maintained. Accessibility to south end of the current NVRT will be improved by constructing 60'x60' gravel parking pad. Portable toilet, picnic table and bicycle stand will be added to the south end parking pad.

VCP is partnering with City of McCall, Parks and Recreation Department, TMC Construction Company, Honey Dippers Portable Toilet Service, Rails to Trail Conservancy fund and private individuals + volunteers for this project. The City of McCall, Parks and Recreation Department agreed to provide the picnic table and bicycle stand. Honey Dippers Portable Toilet company will waive its maintenance fee. Rails to Trail Conservancy fund is expected to contribute for the parking area. Construction Company will provide labor and machinery for construction of the parking pad. Private donors pledged contribution toward the print and design of new maps. Thanks to the above partnerships and donations, VCP is requesting only \$2,300 from the Rotary Club to help offset the cost of design and construction of 2 weatherproof trailhead kiosks with waterproof maps and additional way-finding signs. If sponsored, all maps will include "Thank You" and a logo of the McCall Rotary Club.
