3. Briefly describe your project (who did what, when and where did project activities take place?) in 100 words or less.

Valley County Pathways and all the partners provided new access and parking at the south end of the North Valley Rail Trail, improved orientation by having the kiosks with maps and directions, increased awareness of the trail and improved health and lifestyles of children and /or their families. During the summer, maps and kiosk design was completed along with construction of the kiosks with the completion of the waterproof maps. Kiosks were installed near the city of McCall near the Activity Barn where the trail starts and at the south end further down in Long Valley. Valley County Pathways has been working with Valley County Economic Developmental Council. Trail usage monitoring is in progress.

4. In one brief sentence: who were the beneficiaries of the grant activities and how many of them were there?

Local families, kids of all ages, visitors to the area, snowshoers, walkers, runners, bicyclists, horseback riders, xc skiers and snow bikers. Trail is available to all non-motorized users.

5. How many Rotarians participated in the project?

Several Rotarians work with Valley County Pathways and the local bike group. In addition, Rotarians use the trail.

6. If a cooperating organization(s) other than the beneficiary was involved, what was its role?

VCP is partnered with City of McCall, Parks and Recreation Department, TMC Construction Company, Honey Dippers Portable Toilet Service, Rails to Trail Conservancy fund and private individuals + volunteers for this project. The City of McCall, Parks and Recreation Department agreed to provide the picnic table and bicycle stand. Private donors pledged contribution toward the print and design of new maps. Rotary dollars provided the funds to build the kiosks.
