Project Refuge was planned to provide transitional housing and centralized access to social services for refugees from Somalia and East Africa who have suffered terrible violence and persecution in their homeland and have been granted political asylum in the U.S. We opened on Sept. 1, 2010, and filled up by mid-October. Since then we have been full, with a waiting list. All furnishings were donated. We have now served 18 clients. We have been providing an ESL teacher plus mentors and other teachers, who are mostly Rotary volunteers. Our goal is to teach skills and move clients towards self-sufficiency as quickly as possible. Although La Jolla Golden Triangle RC is the lead club in this effort, 6 other clubs plus San Diego Rotaract are participating with funds, volunteers or both.

Provide a brief (100 words or less) of lessons learned in implementing this grant and how this will improve future grant funded projects: It has been important to try to involve many LJGT club members, with their varied talents, in this project. They have been an enormous help. In addition the involvement of other clubs has added many dimensions. The alliance with Somali Family Service, bringing in the non-profit community agency element, has been critical, with their knowledge of the refugee community, services they provide, provision of staffing and their 501C3. We now also have a Somali Social Work Intern from SDSU. Inotherwords this project could not have come to fruition without this kind of broad-based Rotary/community coalition.
