1. Briefly describe the project.

What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?

USA based Corazon develops communities in very areas such as Tecate near Tijuana. Families earn the right to have a house built by volunteers. YLSRC has been building homes for more than 6 years now. We add a septic tank and to the bathroom, or retrofit homes as needed. The owners are identified by Corazon as cooperative members of the community, helping others, and thus we are provided with deserving families. We purchase the materials at a discounted rate in Mexico. Corazon assists us. We then go to Mexico and install the septic tanks and teach the families how to maintain them. Typically more than 20 of our club members visit during the course of the year and assist with the installation process.

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project?

25 over 6 different trips.

3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples.

Measured the excavation for placing septic tanks;
Measured and cut the piping;
Installed piping and connected to the bathroom;

4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project?

6 Families; at an average of 4 per family, 24, permanently

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?

Hygiene – proper sanitation, reduction of disease, improvement in family health, reduction of sewage run off from pit toilets;

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?

Corazon, based out of Santa Ana. They helped determine which families were to receive the septic tanks, provided personnel to assist with excavation and to purchase all materials locally.
