 The Club joined with the nonprofit Summer Harvest to provide 300 families in need with school backpacks loaded with basic school supplies. The Club responsibility was to purchase the backpacks while Summer Harvest provided the school supplies. We gathered at The Youth Center in Los Alamitos and were joined by other volunteers to load the backpacks and prepare them for distribution.

 The project was conducted in mid-afternoon which limited member participation but, given that, 17 members participated.
