## Project Description

1. Describe the project. What was done, when, and where did project activities take place? If this is a progress report, what remains to be done?

The Katonah ASP group, which included about 60 teenage volunteers with adult support staff went to West Virginia to work on repairing housing for poverty stricken areas of the Appalachia. Several houses were repaired, including roofs, collapsed floors, drainage around the houses was improved to limit erosion and deterioration of the houses

2. How many people benefited from this project? 60

3. Who were the beneficiaries, how were they impacted by this project, and what humanitarian need was met?

Several local families who live in extremely poor conditions were helped to secure safer and healthier living conditions> in addition, the volunteers from the ASP Katonah, which were mostly high school students from the Northern Westchester area, learn a valuable lesson about serving those in need, while picking up important technical skills, working on construction under the supervision of experienced leaders and construction professionals

4. How many Rotarians participated in the project? 1

5. What did they do? Please give at least two examples, not including financial support provided to the project.

Viktor Solarik participated in one of the ASP trips and led one of the teams working on a house repair for one of the selected families. The group managed to install new roof on the house in one week, while also repairing and replacing some of the interior surfaces. This particular household consisted of three retired adults, one of them being seriously ill, bed ridden and unable to take care of himself. The other two adults – husband and wife – were also retired and lived on government support.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?

ASP Katonah is a local non-profit organization. They have been organizing the trips to the Appalachia area for 20+ years, recruiting local high school children to go and help the poverty stricken areas of West Virginia
