## Project Description

1. Describe the project. What was done, when, and where did project activities take place? If this is a progress report, what remains to be done?

The project was planned jointly by the Rotary Club of Yonkers-East Yonkers and the DaySpring Community Center (A WestHab project) in Nodine Hill of Yonkers. It was managed and executed by the Center. Under the Project, an experienced Art Teacher came to the Center to provide students with 2 workshops each consisting of 12 two-hour sessions, one per week to learn visual arts in lessons on various art forms. The project ran from September 2018 to May 2019. The workshops concluded with a public exhibition of the students' art work. Club members assisted in the logistics of the program, publicity, arranging for supplies and after-program evaluation. The project is considered completed.

2. How many people benefited from this project? 60 students

3. Who were the beneficiaries, how were they impacted by this project, and what humanitarian need was met?  
The 60 under-privileged children were the beneficiaries. They were provided with arts training in twelve 2-hour sessions making use of these items. The priority of the project was to help the children realize their potential and to stimulate their creativity. The children are mostly from under-privileged families, with working parents, so the children spent their after-school time. The Center provided the facilities and the Art Teacher provided the supplies. The Children's art work are uploaded to the website.

Participated in meetings, worked with project lead to prepare project document, assisted with the lesson plans. Some Rotarians visited the School to observe the students making use of the provided items and visited the final exhibition.
