An Elder Care Lawyer presented information about financial, medical, and planning concerns for the elderly. Families attended with their older parents. The NYS Health Care Directive, Medicaid qualification information, check lists, and information keepers in Chinese were given out. The workshops were given in Cantonese at a senior center. Information about Rotary was also handed out.

2. How many people benefited from this project? 80+

3. Who were the beneficiaries, how were they impacted by this project, and what humanitarian need was met?  
 Elderly residents of the Chinatown community, many who do not speak English and most of whom are low-income. Their families also benefited. The feedback is that the workshops were very helpful and there have been requests for additional workshop. Most of the participants did not have the basic documents and information to avoid legal and medical difficulties at the end of life.


