Project Description. What was done in 110 words or less?

Partnered with the Tonto Apache Tribe to purchase a trailer to hold the Robot and tools for the high school Robotics group so they could compete in competitions and transport robot and tools to activities. Purchased uniforms and warm up jerseys for Rim Country Middle School boys baseball program and banners so they could participate in uniforms for the first time in all competitions. Program had been without uniforms and banners for the preceding two years. When (dates) and where (city and state) did the project take place?

All purchases occurred in March and April 2019 in Payson Arizona. Payson Unified School Dst.

Who were the beneficiaries?

The Payson Center For Success robotics team, the Rim Country Middle School baseball team

How many Rotarians participated in this project?

6 rotarians participated in purchases. Entire club participated in acceptance.

What did the Rotarians do? Give at least two examples.

Rotarians made contact with community, schools to determine needs. Rotarians negotiated the purchase of the shirts and warmups for students. Rotarians found a co-sponsor for the trailer so it could be purchased by partnering with the Tonto Tribe. Students were witnessed by Rotarians in excelling in the robotics competition and in the baseball season games and activities.

How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project?

20 robotics students, 20-25 parents/staff teachers, 41 students and coaches in middle school

If a cooperating organization was used, what was it's role?

Tonto Apache Tribe partnered with Rim Country Rotary to buy the trailer. We paid one half and they paid the other.
