Lewisville Morning Rotary - Dictionary Project 2018-19

Identified Needs: Students at several campuses in Lewisville ISD are English Language Learners who come from high poverty homes. Many students do not have access to technology or resources to assist them in their educational endeavors.

Project Rationale: The project will ensure that students have access to resources to aid in the English language development, Spanish language development, and content knowledge of  $3^{rd}$  grade TEKS test.

Timeline: Upon receipt of the grant, dictionaries will be purchased and distributed after Christmas brake 2018. Club members will label all dictionaries, deliver to 3<sup>rd</sup> grade classes, present to 3<sup>rd</sup> graders about the importance of literacy for college and career readiness. Approximately 1128 students will receive dictionaries in Spanish/English or English only.

## What did they do?

Once delivered to the 3<sup>rd</sup> graders the Rotarians ask them to put their name in the dictionary. The dictionary was their's to keep. After that exercise we asked them to look up the word ROTARY and what did it mean. Hugs and thank you's followed. A very rewarding day for sure.
