First and foremost, thank you for granting the South Shore Rotary of Staten Island with a matching funds grant of \$1,617.00 at the end of 2018. That amount was matched by South Shore Rotary for a total of: \$3,234.00. We utilized the monies to purchase six (6) \$500 ShopRite gift cards to be distributed to the six of the most needy food pantries on Staten Island (there are over 40 pantries). The residual \$234.00 was judiciously utilized to provide lunches at the two Rotary meetings (Feb. 14 and Feb. 28) for the award recipients.


The distribution of the gift cards was as follows:

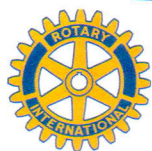
- UAME Church Food Pantry, Rev. Maggie Howard
