HISTORY

H.O.P.E. began in September of 1996 at Aldersgate United Methodist Church. The congregation wanted to help the children in the neighborhood.

(There is no religious education occurring during the H.O.P.E. tutoring sessions.)

H.O.P.E. soon became a nonprofit agency and a community wide organization.

In February 1998 Good Shepherd UMC provided a 2nd site for tutoring. A 3rd site was opened in January 2001 at Epworth UMC and our 4th site in August 2001 at St. Matthew Catholic Church.

In September 2002 we opened sites at First United Methodist Church and at Beautiful Savior Lutheran Church. In February 2005 we opened another site at 1st Presbyterian Church. In September 2015 we opened a site at Greater Community Missionary Baptist Church.

H.O.P.E. wants to help students improve their grades, their attitude and their behavior.

Who are the tutors?

Tutors are community volunteers from all walks of life. Most are not trained teachers. They are business men and women, lawyers, accountants, housewives, retired citizens, college and high school students (at least 16 years old), etc.

What does a tutor do?

- * Primarily helps one student with homework.
- * Interacts with a student in a kind manner.
- * Reads with a student.
- * Uses a computer program with the student.
- * Engages in a learning activity with the student.

How do the students enroll?

Parents must come to the H.O.P.E. Main Office at 2020 S. Collins St. to enroll their student. They must bring the most recent report card. The parents must fill out an application form. Students are accepted according their academic need and availability of a tutor.
