Prior to handing out the dictionaries to the students a Rotarian gives a short presentation about Rotary and the Project. During the presentation highlights about the good that Rotary does throughout the world are given. Also an explanation that the dictionary belongs to each student and as such they should put their name in the space provided inside the front flap! The eagerness and appreciation was border line overwhelming!

One of the many highlights of the event was when Centenarian and SCW Rotarian Fred Hafner handed out dictionaries at the Paradise Charter School. Fred is now 101 years young!
