This project provided complete Thanksgiving meals, including a full size Turkey to over 1,100 families primarily in the south suburban Chicagoland area in underserved communities. This project took place at the Open Access, Inc. operating facility in Homewood, IL on November 22, 2018.
2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? 20
3. What did they do? Please give at least 2 examples.
**1) Assisted with packing 1,100 bags with green beans, cranberry sauce, boxed mashed potatoes, boxed cornbread and boxed dressing mix prior to distribution day.
 2) Assisted in various roles the day of the distribution with duties such as registration, unloading delivered Turkeys from truck, loading up recipients vehicles with bags of groceries and Turkeys and runners who directed traffic and showed the recipients where to go to retrieve their packages.**
4. How many non-Rotarians benefitted from this project? **Over 1,100 families**
5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?
This is an annual event which allows Open Access, with the help of its generous donors, the opportunity to support the local communities of the most vulnerable families in need of a meal, toiletries and/or clothing. In many cases these individuals don't have the resources to provide their families with a full meal on Thanksgiving. Just being involved in this event has inspired others to give to causes such as this as well as other initiatives that they believe in that helps the less fortunate.
6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?
Individuals from other organizations assisted as volunteers. Blue Cross Blue Shield, Easter Seals and Family Christian Center were also present with tables and provided informational handouts and items including bags and socks.
7. How did you share the news of your project?
Word of mouth, e-mail blasts, mass mailings to supporters of Open Access, community leaders, churches, school districts, etc.
