Project Title: Dictionaries for 3<sup>rd</sup> Grader and RYLA Scholarship

## Project Description

1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?

RC Ft Worth-International selected four Primary School where their 3<sup>rd</sup> Grader graders receive their own dictionaries. The four schools averaged 75 students each. Our club distributes the dictionaries as soon as possible during the school year around October-November. Once we get the number of 3<sup>rd</sup> grade students from the schools we order the delivery of the dictionaries. Once we receive the dictionaries, we schedule the schools for the delivery. This tends to be the hardest part. Once scheduled, the students are gathered in the auditorium or library. The project leader explains the main parts of the dictionary then gives the students key words to find in the dictionary and thereby teach them how to use the dictionary. This typically takes between 45 – 60 minutes depending on the number of students. Meanwhile, the other attending club members roam around the room assisting students that need additional help. The student's teacher help as well. It is very interesting watching the students learn how to use the dictionary quickly.

The club also paid tuition to RYLA for a selected student.

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? 15

3. What did they do? Please give at least two examples.

a. As explained above, the lead project Rotarian, explained to the students all about how to find key sections of the dictionary and find key words alphabetically in the book.

b. The remaining Rotarians assisted students that needed additional help and encouraged the faster students to find the designated word as quickly as they can then read the definition.

For RYLA, normally 1-2 Club Rotarians participate as Adult counselors and guide Youth Counselors.

2-4 each school. Sometimes guests of Rotarians and teachers also participated.

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?

The students learn how to use the dictionaries as a reference book to find definitions and correct spelling of words and other information within the dictionary.

At RYLA the students learn how to work with others to achieve fast results of competitive activities as well as learn leadership skills.
