

Final Report for GranyP-2561 Book Trust Project for Greeley Redeye Rotary

The Greeley Redeye Rotary club purchased 80 books through the Book Trust for Maplewood and Martinez Elementary Schools. Both of these school are highly impacted, with a significant number of students who are living in poverty and who are learning English as a second language.

The books purchased through the Book Trust were delivered in February of 2019. Because of a conflict of dates, it was the intention of the Greeley Redeye Rotary to volunteer on another date in the Spring of 2020, when additional books would be delivered.

However, after COVID-19 hit and schools moved to remote learning, this was no longer possible. Our club's intentions were to move the volunteer date to 2021, however, Greeley-Evans School District 6 was not allowing volunteers in schools because of COVID-19. The school district is still not allowing volunteers in schools, and we do not have a date when it might be possible for the Greeley Redeye Rotary members to volunteer in schools for a literacy project.

As soon as possible, the Greeley Redeye Rotary members will arrange to volunteer for a literacy project in Greeley-Evans School District 6.
