Our clients are domestic abuse survivors with children who are struggling to make a secure, peaceful, and stable life for their family. They need a little help and have limited or no support. We have paid \$1,600 in rent over the last 10 months, \$200.13 for clothing, \$234.02 for a bed and 2 sets of sheets for an 6 year old. We have supplied kitchenware and several items that were given to us and which our clients needed. We contact clients at least every 3 months. We are committed for 1 year. If we see efforts are showing progress and the client still has needs after 1 year, we will commit to a second year. All cases are unique and we do not know what is needed until our initial interview. Domestic abuse victims are referred to us by professionals such as the victims witness advocate. The professionals know when families are ready to move on. At that point the Rotary Club of Anaconda is there to help.

Ed & Grace Silverstein & Nikki Powers have met or had multiple contacts with potential clients for initial evaluations and throughout the year. We have accompanied them shopping, made orders online during the pandemic, researched needs and questions online. Shopped for food at Project Care food bank which was free of charge. We partner with NGO's and government agencies when we need their services. The past 4 months communications have been online and one client appears to have no needs at the moment, but has our contact numbers. Another client has moved and is trying to find a work study position thru an insurance program. The rest of the members of our club raise money for SAFE ESCAPE throughout the year with fund raisers such as the Fun Run (4wheeling thru the mountains & food) and a lobster fest with Captain Fred Dailey. Currently we have funds to help 2+ new families on top of the current clients. Clients with children have priority.
