The project took place in the basement of partner United Methodist Church of Le Mars (UMCL) on April, 6, 2019 with volunteers from the church and our club. 50 Chlorine Producing Units (CPUs) were assembled which will be distributed by Safe Water International Ministries (SWIM) in poor countries in Africa, Central America, and other places around the world.

Parts for another 10 CPUs were purchased and donated to SWIM for assembly at another time.
