This is a scholarship district grant request to assist Elisa Cink to attend University 2018/19 Fall. Her Tuition costs \$73,500 per year. This was a matched grant for a total of \$4,000.00 one time.

 - a. These Rotarians reviewed 80 applications to select 6 potential recipients and interviewed all of them at the Jackson Hole High School in person. There was then a vote to select this recipient.
 - b. This money was raised by Rotarians selling sponsored sled-banners through our main winter fundraiser the Annual Sled Dog Race in Downtown Jackson that spans 4 states. It is the largest sled-dog race outside of the Iditarod.
- 4. How many non-Rotarians benefited from this project? 13 all of us. We presented the scholarship to this recipient on Scholarship night in front of the whole High School.

This offsets the education costs for an important student by 5/5%
