

Thank you for being part of the Private Donor Scholarship Program through the Chandler Education Foundation (CEF).

This letter serves as a confirmation of the various scholarships offered by the Chandler Rotary Club, as well as each scholarship's criteria. For the 19/20 school year we are anticipating offering \$11,000 in scholarships (listed below) to the class of 2020.

Chandler Rotary Club Scholarship – (\$8,000)

The Chandler Rotary Club Scholarship was established in 2016 to recognize those students who've demonstrated strong community service and leadership qualities which exemplify the rotary motto, "Service above Self." Four scholarships will be awarded to students attending a university and four will be awarded to students attending a community college or vocational program after graduation. Eight (8) awards of \$1,000.

-  *Minimum 100 hours of community service*
-  *Financial need*

Chandler Rotary Club Battle for Arizona Ave. Scholarship – CHS – (\$1,000)

Chandler Rotary Club Battle for Arizona Ave. Scholarship – HHS – (\$1,000)

The Chandler Rotary Club Battle for Arizona Ave. Scholarships are awarded to a varsity football player from CHS and HHS who most closely exhibit personal leadership and the ideals of each school's football program as defined by the head football coach. Recipients must be members in good standing of each varsity football team. One (1) award of \$1,000 for each school.

Lt. Col. Gary Jones Leadership Scholarship – (\$1,000)

Lt. Col Jones is the Chandler High School Jr. ROTC Commander. He had a distinguished career in the United States Air Force prior to his retirement and assignment to the Chandler High School ROTC program. His program has received many awards from the Air Force and has enabled hundreds of program graduates to become outstanding and successful community members. Recipients must be a member of the Chandler High School Jr. ROTC program and will be selected personally by Lt. Col. Jones. One (1) award of \$1,000.
