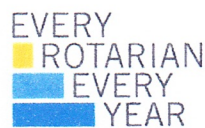

3. Briefly describe the grant and list any changes that might have occurred: (100 words or less) **North Platte High School Administration identified students who were homeless. These students, approximately 40 young people (by March 2020 had increased to 60), survived by moving between friends, or living on their own and working in addition to attending school. NPBS Administration recognized the need to assist these students and created the Student Food Pantry. While the Community provided food donations to stock the pantry, demand is outpacing supply resulting in the need for the pantry to purchase additional food. Students struggle to have appropriate attire for job interviews and uniforms/shoes for employment. The grant will provide funds to fill the gaps for these students.**
4. Provide a brief of lessons learned in implementing this grant and how this will improve future grant funded projects: (100 words or less) **Being involved in the discussion of the poverty impacting our community has been very illuminating for our members, particularly when an impacted student spoke to the Club about the challenges he faces as a 15 year-old on his own. Our community needs assessment has highlighted the volume of substandard housing in the community as well as the high cost for entry housing. For 2019 – 2020, we hope to present a grant request to allow us to participate with other community organizations in improving the situation for our homeless population, particularly families with children.**
