Total: \$21,000

A 50-percent match of \$10,500 combined with the \$5,500 in those donations above not tied to any specific components, would allow us to complete the \$18,000 two-tone granite gold star that is a centerpiece of the plaza, symbolizing the Gold Star Families who have lost a loved one to military service. (The \$200 shortfall would be made up from general donations.)

The dedication of the monument and plaza is tentatively schedule for this fall; however, it will definitely be no later than spring of 2020.

Of course, Pocatello Rotary Club/Rotary District 5400 would be listed on the project's granite Sponsors monument and on the Gold Star Families Memorial Monument permanent website as a Gold Sponsor.
