 Our Club partners with the Baker City Literacy Coalition to order and distribute the books to youth in our community and provide reading sessions to kids in classrooms at 5J School District. Three Rotarians were involved in this project in distribution and reading.

Because our area's per capita income is in the bottom quartile of the state, these books and reading sessions tend to benefit a high percentage of low-income elementary school children. The number of participants is estimated at 400.

- 5. How many Rotarians participated in the project? 3 Briefly tell what did. Involved in book distribution and reading sessions held at the classrooms at School District 5J. Once school closures started, the reading sessions were conducted virturally.

They are involved in the ordering, distribution and reading sessions as well.
