**Project Title** Glenwood School Scholarships

1. Located in Glenwood, Ill., a south suburb of Chicago, Glenwood Academy is a supportive learning community serving over 150 children ranging from ages 7 to 18. The scholarships help enable our students to attend private high schools in our community that offer enhanced educational opportunities for students at risk.

Due to the suspension of school activities due to COVID-19 in the Sp, 2019, the awarding of the district scholarship grants have been postponed until the fall, 2020 when school is back in session. All coordination and communication about the district grant and the awarding of funds has been initiated through The Glenwood School President & CEO Mary Hollie.

We look forward to announcing the recipients of the scholarship funds and completing the project when school districts are allowed to re-open in the state of IL.
