The overall budget of the project was ~ \$10,000 for moving costs, furnishings, and refurbishment expenses. However, this grant of \$4,000 is for two specific budget items: \$2,000 to reimburse First Presbyterian Church for a portion of the costs of flooring and paint that they are providing to spruce up the space (receipts will be provided). \$2,000 is allocated for furnishings to be included in the new space, which will primarily include desks and tables and storage cabinets and similar.
