Project Title 2019 RYLA Scholarships

- Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries? List any changes that might have occurred. Scholarships for students to attend RYLA leadership camp. The scholarships were to cover the expenses for two students to attend RYLA for the entire weekend. RYLA took place at Holiday Home Camp in Lake Geneva, WI from October 11th 14th, 2018. The two students who attended were Tristen Tate and Deanna Baskin
- 2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? 20 Rotarians. 3 from our Club supported our Club's involvement
- 3. What did they do? Please give at least 2 examples. *Rotarians ensured students had transportation to and from RYLA Bus pick up and drop off points. 1 Rotarian from our Club participated in the Reality Store at RYLA. In addition, Club and community members participated in the Report Back Session the Club held for the community, where the students were able to report on their experiences and also to give thanks to Club Members.*
- 4. How many non-Rotarians benefitted from this project? *A total of about 90 youth and their families benefited from the program District-wide. However, specifically to our Club, about 10 non-Rotarians, including the 2 students who were sponsored by our Club, their families, and supportive community members, benefited from the project. One of the managers at the bank where we meet even made a pledge to financially support the project next Rotary Year, because he was so inspired by the report given by the students.*
- 5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project? Our Club expects that the students we sponsored this year to RYLA will be more involved in building our Club's capacity in Rotary Youth Programs, by organizing events to highlight Rotary Youth Programs, such as RYLA, Interact and Rotary youth Exchange. As a result, we hope to get more community youth involved in Rotary Youth Programs and potentially help create a community-based Interact Club and have more students apply to become Rotary Youth Exchange Outbounds and encourage their families to serve as Hosts for Inbounds.



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- 6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role? Although we did not have any cooperating organizations this Rotary Year, we are hopeful that this year's experience will help to build support in years to come.
- 7. How did you share the news of your project? We sent out emails to prospective families about the annual project and solicited other organizations, such as the churches of our members, to make sure they were aware of the program as well. We also invited them to the report back session done by the students.
