The project involved constructing two hand-dug water wells for two rural communities (Zirobwe village and Nakaseke village) in Uganda. During the construction of the water wells, local people were involved in the process by digging the water holes. Then EATBETA used the funds from HEB Rotary and the District grant to purchase the construction materials which could not be afforded by the villagers. Approximately 500 villagers will benefit from the water wells.

The Rotarians (HEB Rotary Club Executive board) reviewed the project proposal and determined that it was a worthwhile cause, hence they approved funding for the project from the club budget and recommended the project for the district matching grant.
