All the above areas were repainted and window panes replaced. The work commenced after the Christmas holidays and it was done and completed before the schools opened for the New Year 2020. The following tasks were done:-


### Store walls

- Painting of the walls listed above and the dining hall walls.
- The old putty was removed together with the broken window panes after which the workman replaced all the broken and missing window panes. According to my observation the work was well done.

The renovated facility will benefit the 200 learners, the 12 support staff, the 20 members of the teaching staff and other stakeholders. In regard to the above I wish to take this opportunity on behalf of the entire Masaku school community to sincerely express our appreciation for the job well done through all the Rotarians who financed the project. As a school we still have other needs i.e. The school needs a perimeter wall to enhance security, canopy over the pathways to protect our needy learners from rain and direct sunshine which is detrimental to some of our learners. We also need facility for foundation class since some of our learners come to school direct from the villages without the basics making it hard to fit the mainstream.
