Project Description

- Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries? Arlington Great Southwest partnered with an organization called New Day to provide food to children who do not have a consistent level of nutrition. The second phase of the project assisted families affected by the loss of jobs & income due to COVID-19. Funds were contributed to the Tarrant Area Food Bank in April.
- How many Rotarians participated in the project? 15
- What did they do? Please give at least two examples. In the first phase, Rotarians purchased the food, assembled the items into packets for over 800 children. As for the Tarrant Area Food Bank, each dollar contributed, provided 3 meals.
- How many Non-Rotarians participated in the project? 10 Rotaractors
- What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project? With such a small scale grant, a long-term community impact is not achievable. What this grant project accomplished was an immediate resolution of hunger for at most one meal for elementary school children. For the clients of Tarrant Area Food Bank it may have provided meals for several days.
- If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role? New Day identified the children in various Arlington elementary schools and made arrangement for delivery
