Who will Foundation Amada Soledad benefit?

Our main target are 12-year-old girls in a vulnerable state. Our foundation is committed to assist them to have access to their cultural identity, and to provide them with the resources they need to reach their full potential.



Our Goal

Provide shelter to girls starting at 12years of age, through education and integration programs which will assist them to integrate into the community social and emotionally. Find inner strength and resilience despite their lives challenges.



Project Description

The girls will be provided with basic needs such as a roof over their head, food, clothing, attendance to school with other children, plus they will receive psychological attention with the use of the Personal Integrative Intervention Model (Modelo de Intervención Integrativo Personalista), supervised by Dr. Rosa Zapién from Universidad Anáhuac (México city).

The main goal is to help them understand and achieve their full potential.



Supporting Strategy

The girls will be provided with training, vocational and psycological support through highly qualified personnel.

We will achieve this with the help of foundation members, donation from other associations dedicated to serve our community and from volunteers.

To provide the girls with emotional and psychological support, as well as to give them an opportunity to find themselves and their purpose in life. Provide a safe environment in which they can grow, learn crucial life skills, find their self-worth and believe in themselves despite the challenges they encounter.




Our Foundation is committed to provide a service to those less fortunate, where positive values and quality morals are practiced and ultimately help them be an active and productive part of our community.






