### Project Description:

2. Briefly describe the project. What was done and where did the project activities take place? Explain how the beneficiaries and other community members were involved?

This project evolved from our original description because of two different years - 2020 & 2021 - which did not allow our club to conduct their yearly service trip to our sister club in Agua Prieta, MX. In prior years our projects included the participation of several Interact students. However, because of the cancellation of the trips, this Interact project was delayed and adjusted. Originally, the project was to purchase and deliver school supplies for the children in Frontera, near Agua Prieta. The funds were, instead used to purchase an air conditioner for the school. Based on our discussions with the Agua Prieta Rotario club, we decided, at their request, to use the funds for a more urgent need (air conditioner) than the originally planned supplies. Our club's intent is to continue our service trips next year, taking Interact students with us, who will then have an opportunity to see their contribution put to good use.
