This program will be supported by local merchants including Sunlight Sports and Wal-Mart. Happy Feet is anonymous, open to any student and provided at no cost.

If you are interested in this program, please complete the consent form on the back and return to your elementary school office. Once the application is processed, local Rotarians will provide a pair of shoes (snow boots if requested) and two pairs of socks to the school to be distributed. A school counselor will present your child with the shoes in private in the school counselor's office.
