- 2. Briefly describe the project. What was done and where did the project activities take place? Explain how the beneficiaries and other community members were involved?

Amaro Tan is a school for low-income and at-risk Roma, Balkan Egyptian, and Albanian children, run by Nehemiah Gateway in the city of Pogradec in southeastern Albania. In addition to education, the school provides hot meals, health and dental services, social worker services and parent engagement, vocational education for a variety of ages, and opportunities for play.

Summer camp is held in August of every year, and extends the social and humanitarian programming of the school to students, in a fun and supportive atmosphere. About 50 children usually participate. This year the team had to contend with local government regulations on group gatherings to prevent the spread of COVID-19. For this reason, camp size was limited to 30 children ages 4-16, with priority based on need. The students were split into small groups, and activities were divided between Amaro Tan campus, Drilon village, and a municipal park near Lake Ohrid in Pogradec.

Strict restrictions on group gathering size—in addition to international travel restrictions—made it impractical to invite Rotarian volunteers to come work with the children.

- 30 children participated in the camp.
- 6. Who are the beneficiaries and what is the expected long-term community impact of this project?

The primary beneficiaries of this camp are low-income, at-risk children from the Roma and Balkan-Egyptian minority groups. These groups disproportionately suffer from poverty, food insecurity, and challenges accessing the state education system—in Albania, only 25% of Roma children complete primary school. Amaro Tan remedies this problem by offering a comprehensive suite of supports to the children and their families, so that the children stay in school, complete primary and middle school, and even go on to high school and college.

In the short term, this camp gives 30 at-risk children a safe place to spend three weeks in the summer, with nutritious meals and age-appropriate activities in a positive, supportive environment. By attending this camp, participants reduce the risk off dropping out of school, and they are less likely to find themselves begging, picking trash, or being trafficked. In the long term, less Roma and Balkan Egyptian children spend their days begging, and more of them complete their education and move on to stable, fulfilling adult lives.

7. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was their role?

Nehemiah Gateway (NG) Albania is a nonprofit organization that offers educational and humanitarian programming in the areas of Pogradec and Gjirokaster, Albania. Amaro Tan is one of its regular programs. Amaro Tan's regular staff ran the camp and staff and volunteers from Nehemiah Gateway helped out with activities and meals.

This is not a new camp, although COVID-19 restrictions caused some changes to the tried and true formula. The Amaro Tan team was able to rely upon past experience to put together and run activities that were enjoyable for the children in locations that were functional and fun. Many of the students had to go home and engage in distance learning starting in March due to COVID-19 restrictions, so they were very excited to go to their school and see their friends and their teachers in August.

14. What did not work well and how would you suggest improving it?

We hope to include more children in the future. We had to limit numbers this year because of COVID-19 restrictions.

15. How was this project publicized?

Limited numbers meant that participation was essentially by invitation from Amaro Tan staff. They have close knowledge of each child's family and home situations, and invited those children whose home circumstances were most urgent.
