In March, due to Covid-19, schools closed for these students and related examinations are deferred. Yesterday, Nepal suffered a record high number of new cases. The students are sheltering in place. Given the latest bad news, predicting when schools for the students will reopen is a fool's errand. Once safe conditions prevail and classes resume, tuition/books and related expenses will be due immediately, thus requiring support via this grant. It bears repeating and especially for Rotarians never seeing firsthand grinding poverty in a very third world country. What many Americans earn in an hour of employment, may be the sole income for a family in Nepal for an entire month! Americans cannot easily understand not only poverty in a very third world country, but also the extreme lack of economic upward mobility. Please note that these students come from very low-caste and extremely poor families. They lack any social, political or business connections to live a decent life in a desperately poor country absent through a good education.
