This project was used to fund travel expenses for a site visit. Funds were also used for a professional video and additional water support for the Navajo through the cooperating organization, Dig Deep. Dig Deep assisted in the organization of this project site visit. Rotarians spent the day in Dilkon and visited the site project. This District Grant is a companion to Global Grant 2092485.

*Who were the beneficiaries?* Navajo families without running water.

5. *What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project?* This project supports global grants that provide clean running water inside homes that previously had no running water. These are life changing projects that are sustainable.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role? Dig Deep is the cooperating organization that is allowed by the Navajo Nation to construct in-home running water systems. Rotary global grants from District 5495 are providing over \$1.2 M in funding for Dig Deep to build the water systems.
