The Rotary Club of Meycauayan East, in response to the call of the national government for non-government organizations (NGO) to partner with government's effort in alleviating the needs of the poorest of the poor and marginalized sector of our community during this time of COVID 19 pandemic have initially distributed 100 pieces of packed lunch with 1 liter bottled water to our community frontliners (barangay tanod, security and police personnel) manning the checkpoints around barangays of Meycauayan City, Bulacan last March 18, 2020.

While there were government aids intended and distributed nationwide during this Enhanced Community Quarantine (ECQ), we believed there is still much effort to be done to help these poorest of the poor to get them through the ECQ which is extended until April 30, 2020. These are the daily wage earners (no work no pay) who do not earn and do not have food to eat during the period of lockdown.

In this time of adversity, we are again pleading from your generous hearts for financial assistance to join us in helping approximately 100 marginalized households in our community by providing with daily essentials to get them through the coming days during the lockdown.
