- 3. Briefly describe your project:
 - This park shelter at Taysom Rotary Park was relocated from Idaho State University in 2004 as a multi-club project to celebrate the Rotary International Centennial. This project made structural repairs to the shelter, installed metal roofing and drip edge, and painted the shelter. In addition, landscape areas were refreshed and replacement landscape plants were installed. This project was more complicated than expected and required assistance from hired carpentry & roofing labor and a professional roofer to complete it. The availability of materials delayed project completion and required additional investment by the club.
- 4. In one brief sentence: who were the beneficiaries of the grant activities and how many of them were there?

This park shelter is used extensively by many of the 50,000 residents of Pocatello, Idaho.

- How many Rotarians participated in the project? Eighteen Rotarians participated in this project doing carpentry, roofing, landscape improvement and painting.
- 6. If a cooperating organization(s) other than the beneficiary was involved, what was its role? This park is owned by the City of Pocatello. The Parks Dept assisted in this project by installing the drinking fountain, providing a dump trailer when we stripped wood shakes off the shelter, and they agreed to pay the entire cost of the metal roofing and drip edge.
