Press Release: Canyon County Sunrise Rotary participates in Dictionary Project.

The Canyon County Rotary club recently completed delivering 500 dictionaries to third grade students at Vision Charter School in Caldwell, Legacy Charter School, and Another Choice Charter School in Nampa. Books were also delivered in the Middleton School District at Purple Sage Elementary, Heights Elementary, and Mill Creek Elementary. Covid 19 restrictions prevented the club from presenting the books individually to each student. Dictionaries were delivered to schools and teachers handed out the books to students. Student dictionaries were also donated to the Idaho Dept. of Juvenile Corrections, Nampa School. Because Canyon County Sunrise Rotary was awarded a grant from Rotary District, there was no cost to schools or student.
