## Dear Rotary District 5400,

As we enter into a new year, I wanted to take a moment to express our sincere gratitude for your commitment to a hunger free and heathier Idaho. Every day we witness the power of your giving; the transformation that takes place when a person realizes that someone cares. We are inspired by donors, like you, who stepped up this past year to embrace your neighbors in need.

The Idaho Foodbank remains steadfast in this same commitment to reach Idahoans who are struggling and provide them the tools they need to thrive.

- We have increased the amount of food we distribute across the state by 44%. This means we are distributing enough food each month for nearly 2.2 million meals.
- We have purchased historic amounts of food spending over 15 times our annual budget.
   In a normal fiscal year, we would spend \$200,000 on food purchase. As of December 2020, we have spent over \$3 million to secure food by the truckload.
- We have effectively coordinated the delivery of USDA "Farmers To Families" food boxes into the hands of hungry Idahoans through our Mobile Pantries, our statewide community partner sites and mass-scale "Community Food Distributions."
- We have realized a 5-year strategic goal by moving our Boise operations to Meridian. This
  new facility expanded our physical capacity to receive and distribute food to over 465
  statewide partners schools, food pantries, senior centers, feeding sites, shelters, and
  churches organizations devoted to serving their communities and providing Idahoans
  the resources to move from insecurity to independence.
