This project supports a very successful event that benefits the kids of Fullerton. Our community partners help us achieve our Rotary goals and we want to return the favor in the form of a grant. The Fullerton Arboretum is a nonprofit organization that hosts every elementary school in Fullerton, and the surrounding areas, year round. Kids learn about nature through various gardens, ponds, tours, and learning labs. This facility maximizes its annual calendar to accommodate the various schools, groups, and 1,000s of kids.
