Dear Jeremiah,


Please excuse the lateness of this communication. We are relieved to be past the craziness of the pandemic surges and are pleased to have time to focus on thanking those who provided support during the pandemic, including the Grand Island Sunrise Rotary.

We gratefully received the \$600 donation in November 2020 from the Sunrise Rotary with the intention of buying thermometers to distribute to residents who were at risk for COVID-19 so that they could self monitor. The goal was to distribute 300 thermometers to those who demonstrated a need. However, at the time we were purchasing thermometers, we found that only 24 thermometers could be purchased due to a lack of supply and a greatly increased demand. This was a total of \$49.50. We retained the remaining funds until we found a suitable purpose where we could provide assistance to those most in need. Thermometers continued to be impossible to purchase so we looked for other ways to assist the community.

As vaccine became available, we recruited volunteers to assist with our COVID-19 clinics held at the Community Fieldhouse at Fonner Park. We committed the remaining funds from the Sunrise Rotary donation to purchase a lunch and bottled water for the community volunteers who faithfully gave of their time and energy to help in the clinics week after week.
