The Back-to-School Fair Project funding was donated to Interfaith Ministries of Denton, a non-profit agency, that in coordination of Health Services of North Texas, the Denton Independent School District, and the City of Denton Police, started the citywide fair in 2019 for the purchase and distribution of school supplies to students in the Denton Independent School District and surrounding areas annually. The grant and club match for the purchase of school supplies in May and June (2021) for the purchase of school supplies that will be distributed in August 2021 to school students in the Denton area.


