

Four Things You Need to Know About Education in Haiti

- 1. Almost all schools in Haiti are privately run
- 2. Most schools ask for tuition fees, a barrier for many

- 3. Enrollment rates have risen from 78% to 90%
- 4. Waiving tuition fees can help children be in a grade that's appropriate for their age




The School - Ecole Communautaire Lumière de Jésus - Ecluje

- 6 grades
- 57 graduates
- Funding 2010-16 from private diaspora
- 2017 Sfaira Foundation (Canadian NGO) agreed to pay teachers for a period of at least period of 5 years, under the condition ECLUJE is looking for a partner to build own facilities







Sanitation Challenges



- Water and Sanitation is one of Rotary's Focus areas
- Haiti didn't have any central waste treatment before 2011
- We did extensive research and knowledge exchange with experts globally and locally
- Environmental impact will be cooperated in school's curriculum and compost and waste management actively taught



3 Phased Fundraising Approach







Original Funding Leve 10.000 USD

- Site location, design, work planning
- Project mobilization, excavation and foundations
- First Floor completed Second floor slab and columns completed.

Phase 1 15.000 USD

- Fully functional 2 floors of usable space.
- On site water storage and plumbing completed.

Phase 2 25.000 USD

- 3 floors with classrooms
- Roof Terrace for outdoor activities




