



A few years ago, my world was turned upside down by the most significant experience in my life; my family left our home in Lahore, Pakistan, and moved to Estes Park, Colorado. I had to learn a new language, adapt to a different culture and find a way to thrive in school. Not knowing the language was one of the greatest challenges of my life. I cannot tell you how hard it was to sit in a classroom full of people with great intellects discussing a certain topic, while struggling to understand and not being a part of the conversation because I simply didn't know how to speak their same language. I always had a lot to share but suddenly I could no longer contribute. Lunch and passing periods were frustrating, but class time was the worst. How could I show my gratitude for all my parents' sacrifices? How could I let my teachers know of my commitment towards learning? I did not give up, I had grit and determination. I stayed after all of my classes to ask the teacher questions in order to more fully understand the lesson. I stayed up late defining words and trying to read into the text. I showed up early to get prepared before each class. By doing that, I finished my English Language Learners Course within a year of school, improved my previous grades to better grades by the end of the year and worked my way up to teacher's and my own expectations. Within two years I was able to prove my abilities. I was contributing my thoughts and ideas in the same discussions that evaded me just a short time ago. Today, I'm now enrolled in a college level literature class. I have earned 16 academic and colorguard awards throughout my high school journey.

Although things have been very difficult for me in adjusting to an entirely new culture, patience, dedication, and perseverance got me through and I have learned amazing life lessons because of it. I realized that I'm the person that sets my own limits. Although my father works very hard to support all of us, the cost of my college education in the United States will be a big challenge for us. Just the other day, I happened to be at the library with my dad where he was filing his taxes and it was a little over 47,000\$ for the whole year. Imagine yourself providing for a family of five everyday for the past five years. Once in college, my goal is to become a special education teacher. If I get selected for your scholarship, I will never forget that I am also an ambassador, representing you wherever I go, and I look forward to the time when I can repay this society for the opportunities I have been given.

Another aspect important to me is to work my hardest to add value to my community. I am eager to learn new things, to work hard, to overcome challenges, to be the best that I can be in university and beyond. It is already clear that what felt like a hardship four years ago, in learning a new language and adapting to a new culture, is actually one of the biggest blessings I have ever experienced.

A major thing that has shaped who I am is because of my younger brother who has intellectual disability and autism. It's difficult to take care of him but we do it because we love him and that's what inspires me to become a special Education teacher. I want to be a very successful teacher for all the special needs children so I can contribute to giving them a bright future. With a very prosperous future, I can add value to mankind in general and along with my organization, my community, my country and my family.
