Project Title: RYLA Student Assistance

Project Description

1. Briefly describe the project. What was done, when and where did project activities take place, and who were the beneficiaries?

The district grant and club match enabled Denton Rotary Club #1779 to sponsor seven high school students from the Denton, Texas area to the 2021 RYLA sponsored by District 5790. The event will occur from June 17 through 20, 2021 at Tarleton State University in Stephenville, Texas. Our Club Youth Services Chair contacted local high schools and provided information to interested students to apply online with the district. The district submitted applicant names to our club after review. At that point, the applicants were interviewed by our Club Youth Service personnel. Seven students from the Denton and Argyle areas will be sponsored for the 2021-22 RYLA. The seven students are listed in our grant documentation. Their participation in RYLA will develop their leadership skills through experiential and fun activities, increase their confidence, build teamwork skills, learn proper business and social etiquette expand skills in civic and ethics, and immerse them in a community service project. Our club also will provide transportation to and from the event for students who need it.

6. If a cooperating organization was involved, what was its role?


Our club recommended two additional RYLA applicants to the Denton-Lake Cities Rotary, and that club agreed to sponsor those students to attend RYLA.
