

Grant for Ugandan toilet building/toilet
Application for \$2,600 Rotary Grant (\$900 club and \$1700 district)

Sean Kinobe wanted to start a school in the village of Jinja, Uganda. In the fall of 2020 I asked my Facebook friends to raise money for school supplies. Many of my friends and family and a few individual members of the Downtown Tempe Rotary Club have helped to provide school supplies to help these students. Sean and I started Lynette Shaw-Smith Education Center, which is a community school.

The parents of our 54 registered then got involved. The parents enthusiastically support the school. They have all gone together to pay the full-time teacher's salary. They pay rental of the school building and the Internet data bills. They laid floors in the classrooms and built the fence. The parents and students made jewelry that they sent to me to sell for a fundraiser. They are currently making angel and star ornaments for another fundraiser.

Now we are looking at bigger expenses that we cannot do on our own.

This grant will pay for a toilet building. Now the kids are using buckets in the classrooms, and staff are going in the bush. The engineer had a higher price for bigger toilets, but he planned a smaller facility and agreed to let parents and our skills students help with labor to cut the cost to \$2,600. See attached receipts and plans for toilets.

No one in the village had an address, so I could not transfer our money to anyone. Fred Chalfin, President of the Tempe Rotary Downtown club, suggested I contact the closest Rotary Club to the school. Lynn Gustke did research and found the closest club, and then I contacted Michael Muwanguzi, president of the Source of the Nile Rotary Club. He has been receiving the money transfers and giving the cash to Sean. He has also been advising Sean. We have gotten receipts and pictures of everything purchased, so we know how our money has been spent.

We will publicize Rotary's involvement in our newsletter and on signs displayed at the school.
