Members will be involved in the logistics, setup of the meal service and distribution. Additionally they may participate in other activities like reading to children or any permissible social interaction.

	Funds will be tracked by the Club and our Foundation treasurer and by the project lead

	Funds will be used to purchase food, paper goods / utensils and supplies to prepare the meals, package and distribute them at the location. We estimate the cost of \$11 per meal and expect to feed about 60 families, We plan to do this 5-6 times in the year.
