Project Description

Dictionaries were prepared by Sun Lakes club members by affixing stickers and inserting bookmarks. Dictionaries were donated and delivered to all third grade students in the Chandler Unified School District by members of Sun Lakes Rotary Club

Dictionaries were prepared on October 13, 2023 and delivered between that date and February 7, 2024, all in Chandler, Arizona, USA

All third grade students in the Chandler Unified School District

2. How many Rotarians participated in the project? 48 Rotarians participated in preparing the books for delivery, 41 performed the deliveries

The Rotarians met to apply stickers and insert bookmarks for all dictionaries. The books were then apportioned to members for delivery to their respective schools. The Rotarians then delivered the dictionaries directly to the students in their classes

5. What are the expected long-term community impacts of the project? Students will become acquainted with the use of dictionaries and will be able to improve their academic performance, plus they will have a dictionary to use for as long as they wish.
